Dear Friends,

It gives me immense joy and happiness to once again convey my greetings of love, hope and peace to you this Christmas season.

Each year we celebrate Christmas as a joyous occasion, a time of celebration of gift exchange and sharing, at the same time remembering the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ whose birth heralded a new era of hope and love to us humankind. His birth signified peace to us as he himself is the Prince of Peace.

For a child has been born for us, a Son given to us; authority rests upon his shoulders; and he is named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
